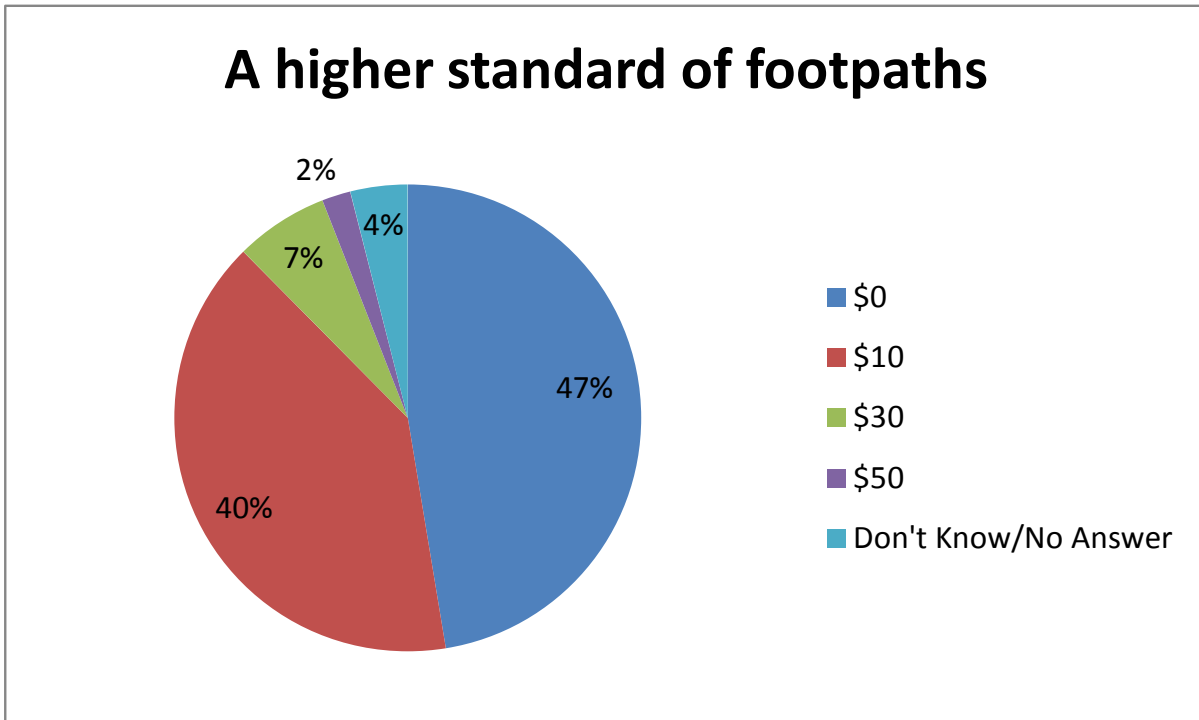
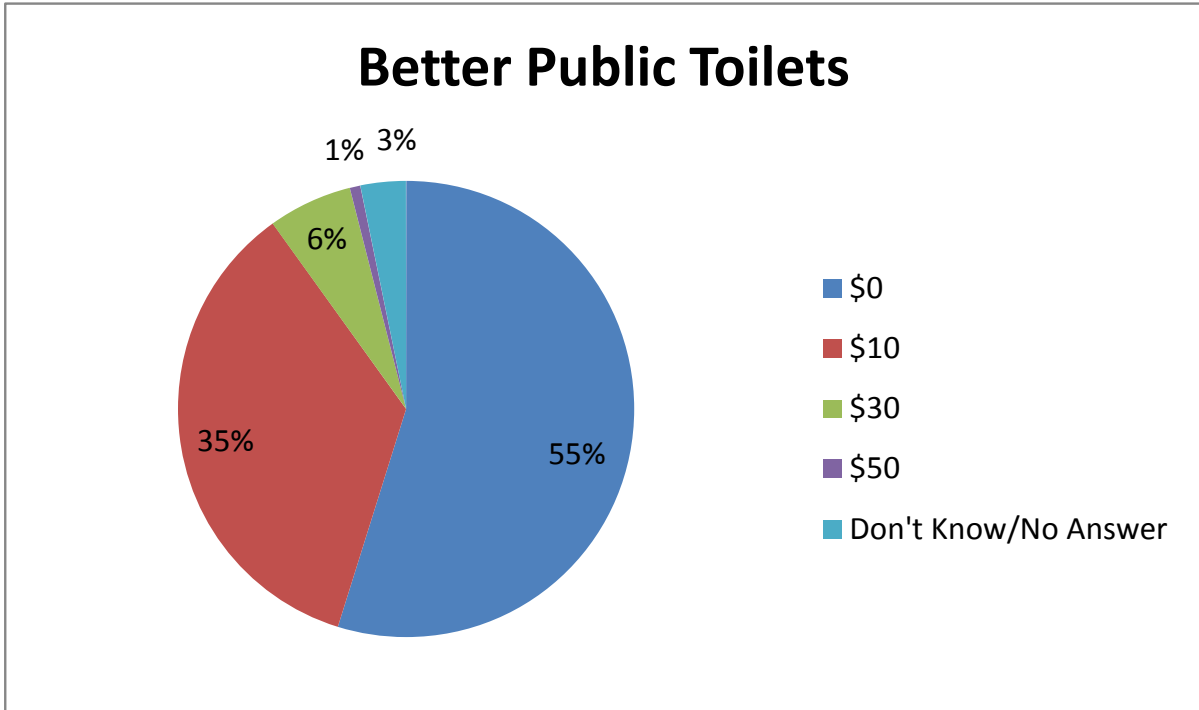


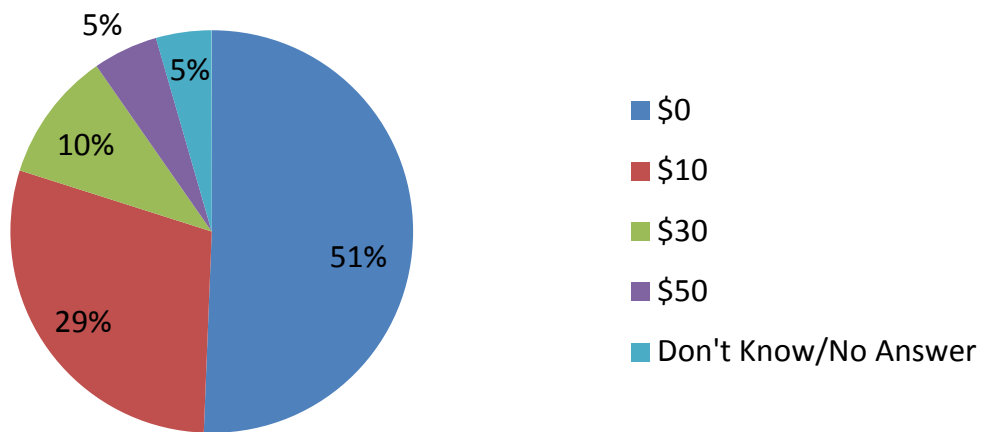
LTP Pre-consultation Results

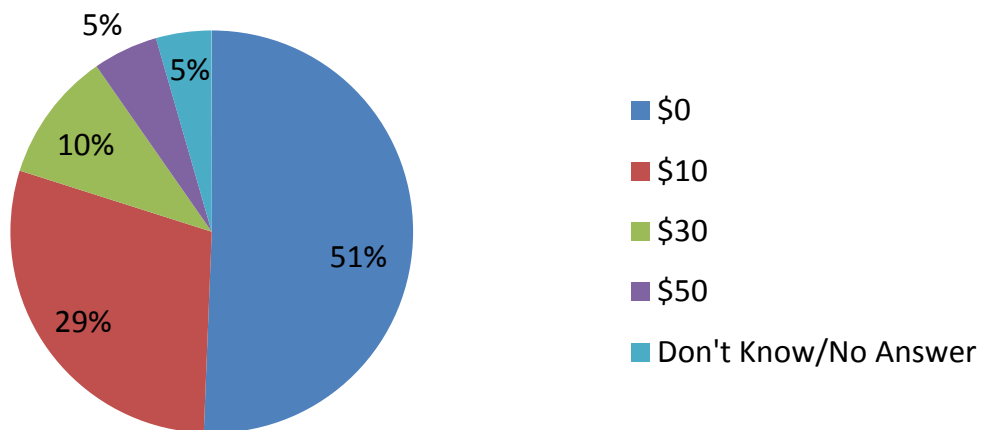
Q1. To get an improved level of service for the following areas, how much more would your household be prepared to pay via rates per year?



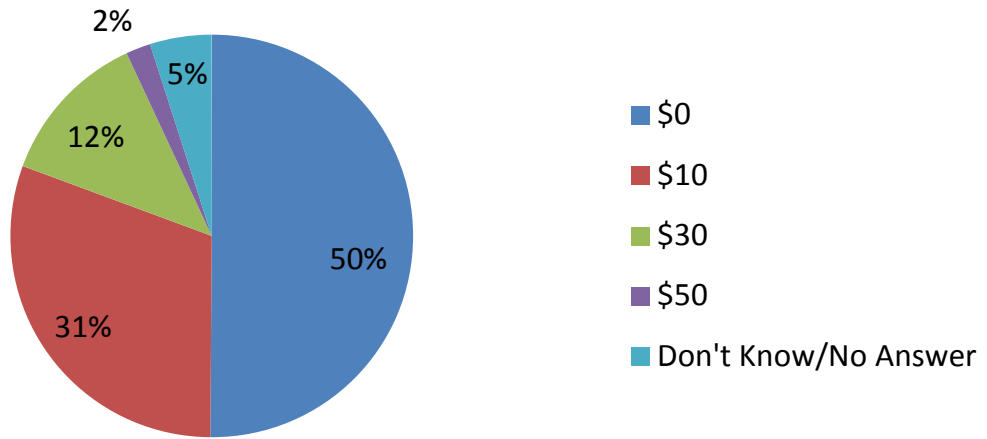
Better roading maintenance in rural areas



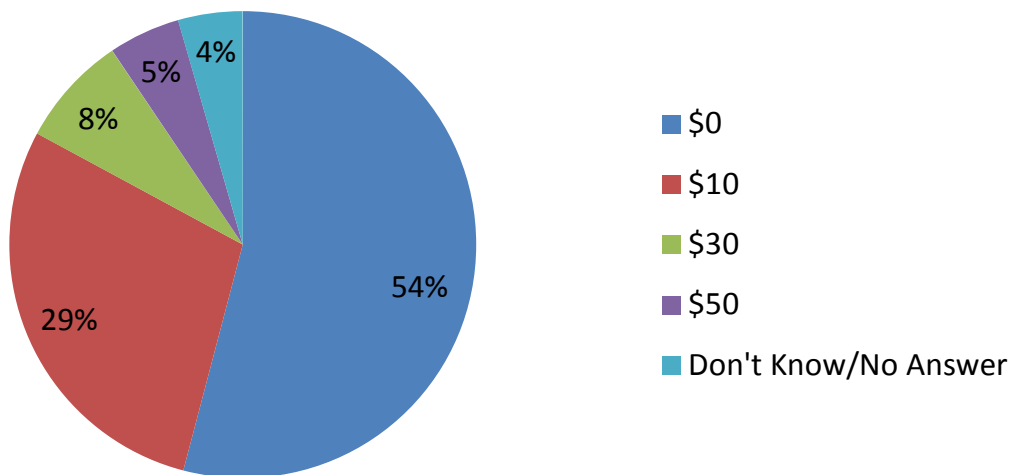
Better roading maintenance in rural areas



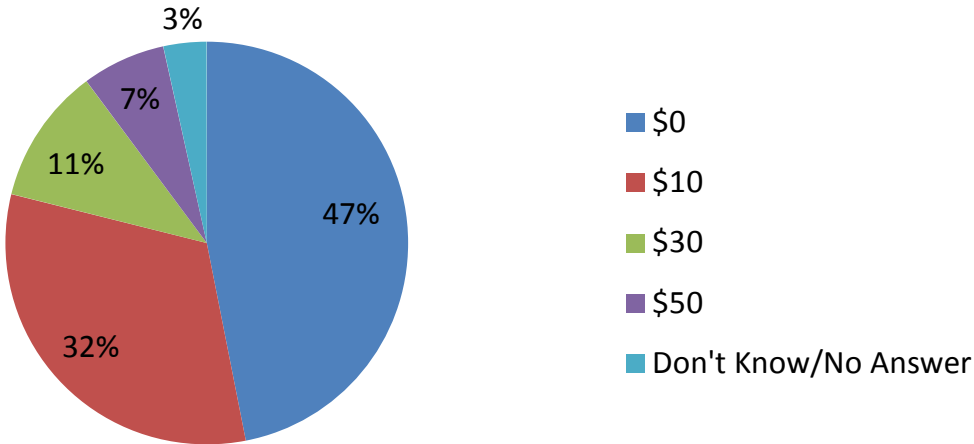
Better roading maintenance in urban areas

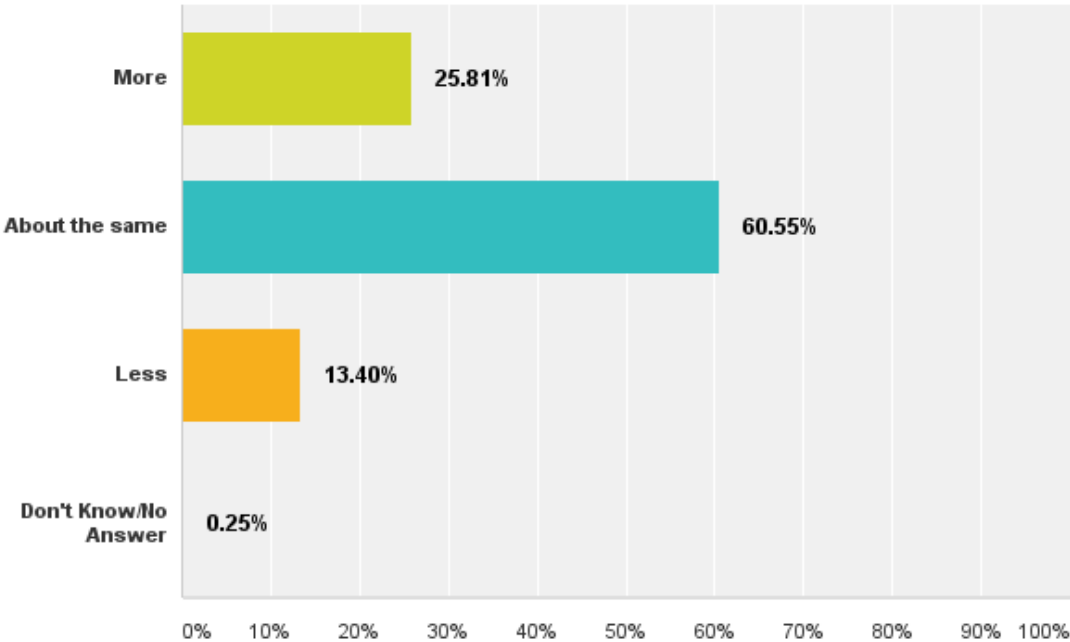

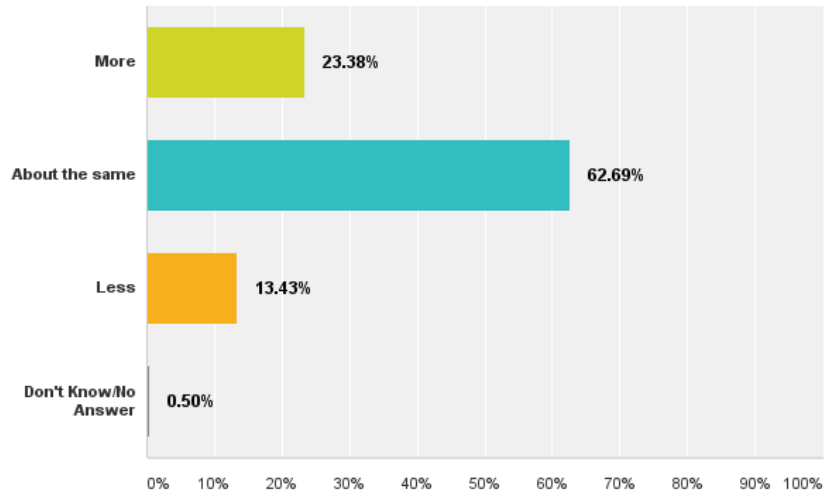
Q2 Should the Council spend more grants money directly on events, about the same or less?

Answered: 403 Skipped: 1



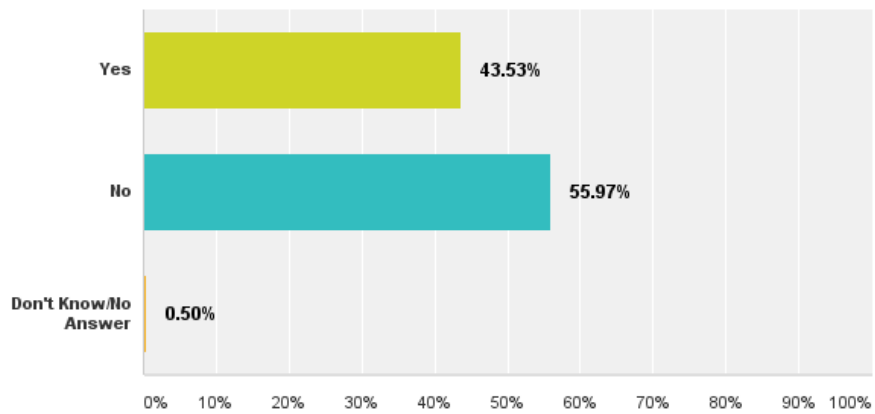
Q3 Should the Council spend more grants money directly on community organisation and facilities, about the same or less?

Answered: 402 Skipped: 2



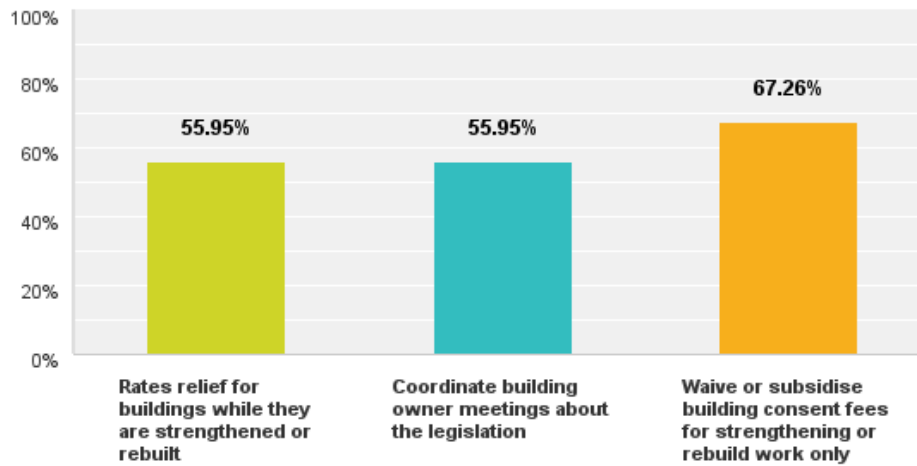
Q4 Should Council be more proactive than the legislation requires?

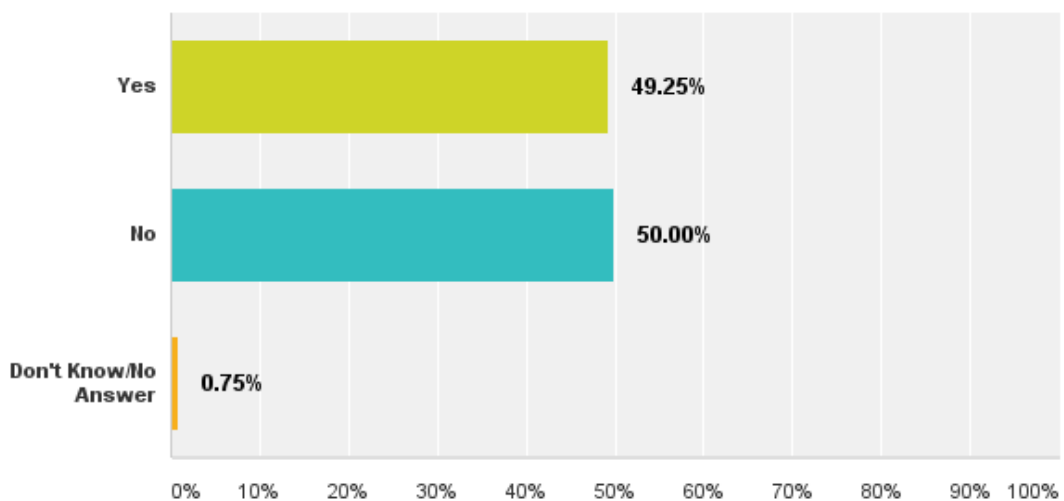
Q5 If yes, which of the following measures would you support, funded from rates?

Q6 Should Council support Environment Canterbury to address air quality issues through enforcement measures, such as banning open fires and requiring upgrades to older woodburners?

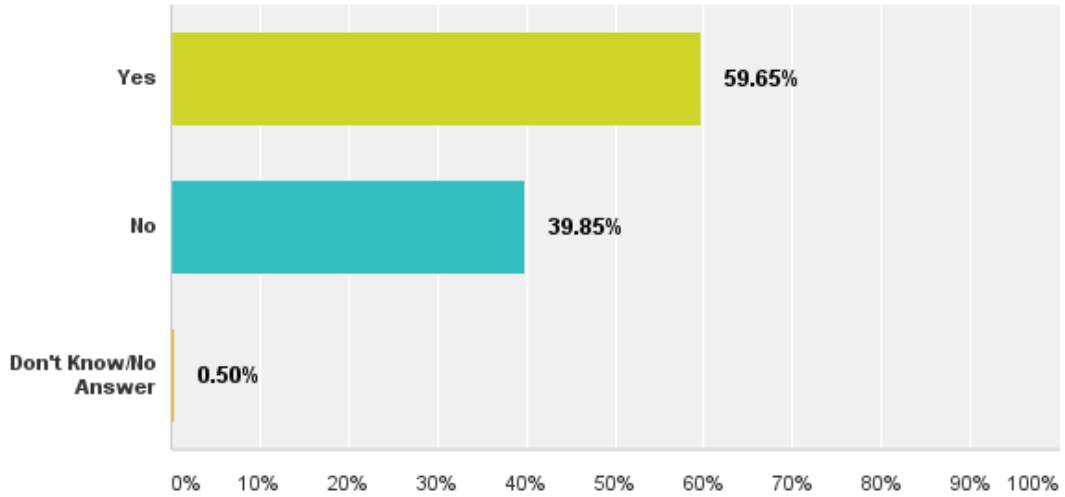

Q7: Would you support Council spending more to encourage increased population growth?

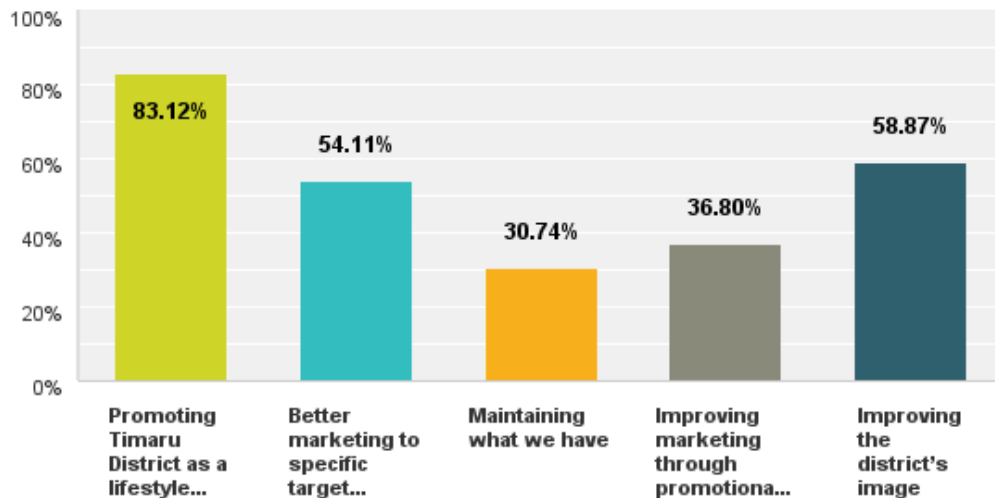
