

PAYMYPARK SERVICE EXPANDED

PayMyPark is the new to Timaru cell phone app that enables people who want to park in the Timaru CBD to pay for their parking using their cell phone. It was introduced a few weeks ago and is steadily growing in popularity.

The app provides an extra layer of customer service that Council had been looking to introduce, but was unable to until parking enforcement shifted over to an electronic platform instead of the hand written infringements. The app has now been expanded across all pay and display car parks as well as stand alone parking meters.

To use simply download the app to your cell phone from paymypark.com to access casual parking, or if you really want to make it work for you and save a little money over the casual rates, set up an account.

You can either pay for parking in 15 minute increments or use a start/stop function, meaning you only pay for the minutes you use. The app will send you a reminder of when your time is almost up and you can remotely top up if you choose to. It's a great little app and we would like to see both members of the community and our business community take advantage of its flexibility for their own convenience.

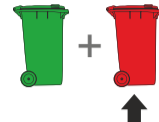
