Availability of Summary of Decisions Requested in Submissions to Proposed Timaru District Plan Change No. 15.

Proposed Timaru District Plan Change No. 15 is a private plan change request made by Goldpine Industries Ltd, Graybird Holdings Ltd and J. & B. Christie Holdings Ltd to rezone land located at 16 and 22 Martin Street, Washdyke, Timaru, from Residential 4 zone to Industrial L zone.

A summary of all decisions requested in submissions to the Proposed Plan Change No. 15 has been prepared. This summary is available for inspection during normal office hours at:

No later than 10 working days after the day on which this public notice is given, the following persons may make a further submission on the proposed plan change:

- any person representing a relevant aspect of the public interest; and
- any person that has an interest in the proposed plan change greater than the interest that the general public has; and
- the local authority itself.

The submission must be made on prescribed form (Form 6) and received by Timaru District Council, P O Box 522, Timaru on or before the last day for submissions, being 15 July 2011. Further submission forms (Form 6) are available from the locations outlined above and on Council's website (www.timaru.govt.nz).

A further submission must be limited to a matter in support of or in opposition to a submission made in respect of the proposed plan change.

Where a person makes a further submission that person is required, within 5 working days after providing the submission to the local authority, to serve a copy of the further submission on the person who made a submission to which the further submission relates.
