Class: Hooray!

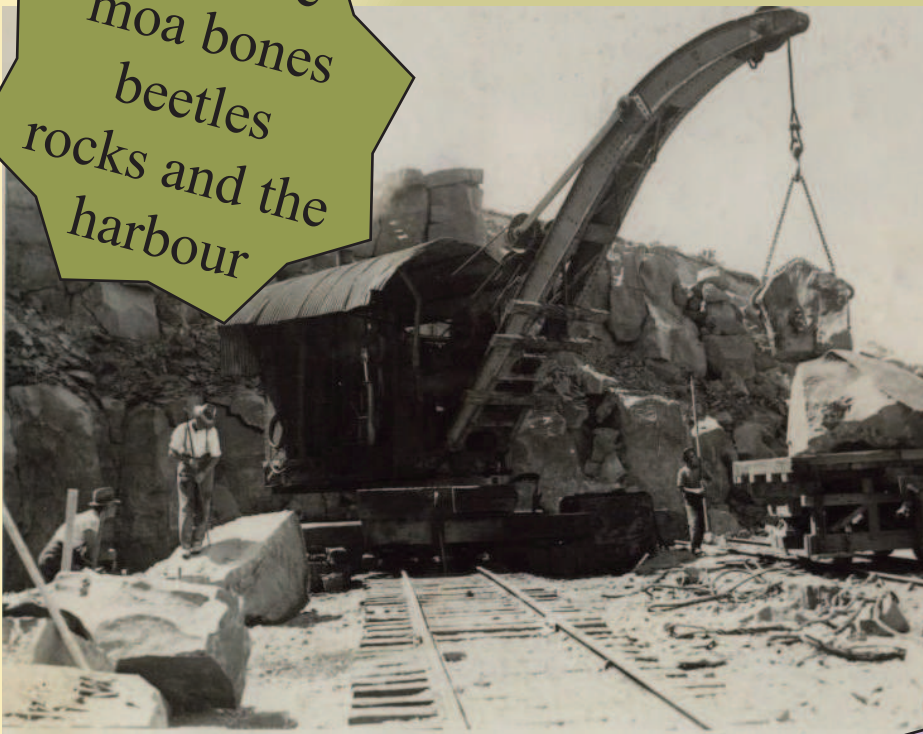
Teacher: We will have the other half this afternoon!
