What's that beetle called? its a Megadromus crassalis

- *it's big - about 35 mm long*
- *it's nasty! it eats other insects, worms and soil creatures*
- *it stinks! it releases a bad smell if larger creatures grab it*
- *it's ours because it is only found in South Canterbury. There are 30 or more Megadromus species but this one is the largest!!*
