Arowhenua residents will be delighted that they can look forward to improved sewer facilities, after \$672,000 of Government funding has just been confirmed to cover some of the capital cost of upgrading their existing individual septic pits which are liable to flood in extreme weather conditions.

Timaru District Council's Drainage & Water Manager, Grant Hall said "Having this chunk of money makes the whole project more viable. The community will still have to fund some of the project, but this is a definite step in the right direction".

Consultants, Opus are currently working on the design of the new scheme to link existing septic waste pipes to a central pump which will connect to the Temuka main sewer. The finished design will be presented to Arowhenua residents by the end of September.
