



REGISTRATION OF INTEREST – AROWHENUA SEWERAGE SCHEME

Timaru District Council invites Registrations of Interest from suitably qualified contractors for construction of: a main pumping station and 1.3 km of DN90 sewage rising main from Arowhenua to Temuka; approximately 3km of low pressure sewer reticulation within Arowhenua township; installation of individual domestic pump stations at 32 properties including minor gravity sewer work at the properties and pumping lateral connections to the reticulation in the street.

Associated works include directional drilling /thrustboring across SH1, pipe crossing across the Temuka Bridge and connection of the rising main into an existing manhole in King Street, Temuka.

Prospective tenderers will need to clearly demonstrate their expertise and competence to fulfil the requirements of the contract to construct the above sewerage scheme.
