# Temporary Traffic Management Assurance Model

**Low-risk** issues are typically not subject to fees for the contractor, as they can be addressed immediately to ensure safety. However, these will be recorded for tracking non-compliance.

**Medium-risk** issues may result in fees for the contractor, depending on the severity and the time taken to resolve them.

**High-risk** issues which pose a greater threat to safety or project timelines, will incur fees as the contractor has been previously notified that ongoing issues of this nature will lead to invoicing.
