

- 1 This memorandum is filed on behalf of the Timaru District Council (**Council**) in response to Minute 48, which contained questions for section 42A authors in response to their final replies presented at Hearing H.
- 2 The purpose of this memorandum is to:
 - (a) file evidence responding to Minute 48 from:
 - (i) Andrew Willis;
 - (ii) Matt Bonis;
 - (iii) Liz White; and
 - (iv) Andrew MacLennan; and
 - (b) respectfully seek extensions of time to file the evidence of Ms Williams and Mr Boyes to **Friday, 10 October 2025**.
- 3 Ms Williams is seeking further clarification from Council's Land and Transport Manager. Mr Boyes and Ms Williams are undertaking further work in relation to the definitions of community activities, cultural activities, and recreational activities which may have implications across the PDP.
- 4 Counsel advises that the Council also intends to file a further version of the PDP provisions capturing the final recommendations of s42A authors on **Friday, 10 October 2025**.
