RATES REBATE

Are you eligible and made your application for the 2020/2021 rating year?

If you have already been granted a rates rebate between the period August 2020 and May 2021 then please wait until you receive notification from us to make an appointment for the 2021/2022 rating year.

If you have not already applied for a rebate for the rating year 1 July 2020 to 30 June 2021 and would like to check your eligibility, please ring the council to arrange an appointment with a staff member. At the appointment the staff member will guide you through the process.

Applications will be accepted up to 30 June 2021. The purpose of the Rates Rebate Scheme is to provide a subsidy to low income home owners on the cost of their rates.

the number of dependents you have.

The maximum rebate for 2020/2021 is \$655.00. **Please bring the following to the appiointment:**

Washdyke Flat Road

Partial Closure – for 1 week commencing between approx 8th - 18th June

We're installing new asphalt on Washdyke Flat Road, from State Highway 1 to Laughton Street.

PLUMBSOLVENCY

DRINKING WATER STANDARDS

Each year, as part of the Ministry of Health requirements, we are required to remind you that some plumbing fittings have the potential to dissolve and release very tiny traces of metal into the water which has been in domestic taps and pipes for several hours eg – overnight, when you've been away on holiday or at your holiday home.

Even though the health risk is small the Ministry of Health guidelines recommend that the first mug full of water each day is not drunk but, for example, is used to water plants etc as this will remove the traces of metal from the water.

We recommend this simple precaution to all households, whether you are on public or private supply.
