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Introduction

- My name is Andrew Willis. I am the director of Planning Matters Limited (a town planning consultancy). I prepared the s42A reports on the Strategic Directions, Contaminated Land, Hazardous Substances, Stormwater, Energy and Infrastructure, Transport, Drinking Water Protection, Natural Hazards, Coastal Environment, and the Financial Contributions chapters. I confirm that I have read all the submissions, further submissions, submitter evidence and relevant technical documents and higher order objectives relevant to those chapters. I have the qualifications and experience set out in my s42A reports.
- The purpose of this statement is to respond to Panel Minute 48 (dated 24 September 2025).

Panel directions - Minute 48

- Minute 48 (paragraph 9) directed that I "...undertake a review of all references to Regionally Significant Infrastructure in Part 1 Introduction and General Provisions, and specifically the Description of the District Section, and advise any further recommended changes as a result of changes to the definition."
- In paragraph 6.10.19 of my s42A report on Energy and Infrastructure, Stormwater and Transport (dated 11 December 2024), I recommended amendments to the definition of Regionally Significant Infrastructure (**RSI**) as follows:

Regionally Significant Infrastructure is:

a. Strategic land transport network, including National Routes, Regional Arterials and District Arterials, and arterial roads

[...]

f. The National Grid electricity transmission network

[...]

m. The electricity distribution network

n. The Redruth Landfill and Resource Recovery Facility in Timaru¹

- I have reviewed references to RSI in Part 1 Introduction and General Provisions, and specifically the Description of the District section. Having reviewed Part 1, I note that the Infrastructure section (in the Description of the District section) includes a bulleted list of the district's RSI which does not contain the recommended changes to the definition of RSI identified in my s42A report. If the Panel is minded to accept my recommended amendments to the definition of RSI in the definitions chapter, then in my opinion the bulleted list of the district's RSI should also be amended as a consequential amendment within the scope of the original changes.
- There are no other references to RSI that would warrant changes to Part 1.
- In terms of a s32AA assessment, in paragraph 6.10.30 of my s42A report I provided a s32AA assessment in support of my recommended changes to the RSI definition. I consider that this s32AA analysis also applies to the above recommended amendments, which are consequential to the definition change.

Amended provisions

The amendments proposed in this final reply are set out in double <u>underline</u> and double <u>strikethrough</u> as follows (changes in red font are as per the Council's previously recommended standardisation changes):

- <u>Community</u> potable water systems;
- **<u>Ee</u>**stablished community-scale irrigation and stockwater infrastructure;
- Itransport hubs:
- Bbulk fuel supply infrastructure including terminals, wharf lines and pipelines;
- The electricity distribution network; and
- The Redruth Landfill and Resource Recovery Facility in Timaru.²
