We have checked the Council technical review, and it appears they have not picked up the errors with cross reference to the rules.

There are incorrect cross references in rules as follows:

1. NOISE-R1 - Exclusion 5 should refer to GRUZ-R16 not GRUZ-R15
2. NOISE-R12 – Helicopter landing sites not addressed by GRUZ-R14 should refer to GRUZ-R16.
