



6 GENERAL RULE

- **6.0** Unless otherwise provided for in this Plan all activities which do not comply with any General Rule are non-complying activities.
- 6.0.1 An exception to Rule 6.0 applies to the development of land essential to the ultimate establishment of a permitted, controlled or discretionary activity on that land by means of:
- (1) The alteration, removal or demolition of any structure or part of any structure in, on, under or over the land; or
- (2) The excavation, drilling, tunnelling or disturbance of the land other than mining, quarrying or extraction of materials occurring naturally on or beneath the site; or
- (3) Any destruction of, damage to, or disturbance of the habitats of plants or animals in, on or under the land.
- (4) This rule is expressly subject to any specific rules either listed as an activity or addressed by performance standards in the zone rules or in these General Rules.
