The owner of a dog must keep the dog under control at all times.

The owner of any dog must:

- ensure that the dog receives proper care and attention, and is supplied with proper and sufficient food, water, and shelter; and
- ensure that the dog receives adequate exercise

The owner of a dog must ensure, when the dog is on land or premises occupied by the owner:

- that the dog is under the direct control of a person; or
- that the dog is confined within the land or premises in such a way that it cannot freely leave the land or premises

Replacement discs may be obtained from the Timaru District Council if the current disc has been lost or stolen.

CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP

Where the ownership of a registered dog has changed, both the previous owner and the new owner must each give written notice within 14 days to the Territorial Authority or Authorities concerned of the change of ownership, the new owner's residential address, and the address at which the dog will ordinarily be kept.

If the fee for registration of a dog is paid and that dog dies, a refund will be made on request as follows:

- where the dog dies during the year, $1/12^{\text{th}}$ of the annual fee for each complete month remaining in the registration year after the date of application for a refund, by completing a deceased dog refund form.

Owners wishing to claim a reduced fee for neutered dogs must produce a certificate from a registered veterinarian certifying that the dog has been neutered, or make a statutory declaration before a designated officer.
