This is a further submission in support of, and in opposition to, submissions on:

• the Proposed Timaru District Plan ("Proposed District Plan")

The Diocese has an interest in the Proposed Timaru District Plan that is greater than the interest the general public has, for reasons including the following:

- The Diocese has an interest as the proprietor of five State Integrated Catholic Schools within the Timaru District. The State Integrated Schools (SIS) were integrated under the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 and are part of the Minister of Education's ("Minister") network of schools within the Timaru District. SIS's have a legally defined special character which is enshrined in an Integration Agreement (IA) between the Crown and the Proprietor (owner) of the school.
- The Diocese has an interest as a landowner in respect to existing and future educational infrastructure that is potentially affected (directly or indirectly) by the relevant submissions.
- The Diocese makes this further submission in respect of submissions by third parties to the Proposed Timaru District Plan.

## Catholic Diocese of Christchurch's further submissions

• In respect to the Proposed District Plan, the Diocese support of, or opposition to, a particular submission including the reason for the Diocese's support or opposition and the relief sought are detailed in the table attached as **Appendix A**..
