NOMINATIONS

Nominations for all positions open on Friday 19 July 2019.

Nominations must be made on the appropriate nomination paper for each position, available from the relevant Electoral Officer.

Completed nomination papers must be received by the appropriate Electoral Officer no later than **12 noon on Friday 16 August 2019**.

Each nomination must be accompanied by a deposit of \$200 (incl GST), payable by eftpos, cash or online banking (see candidate handbook for requirements).

Candidates may submit a candidate profile statement and recent photograph for sending out with voting documents to electors. The requirements for profile statements and photos are outlined in a Candidate Information Handbook which is available with the nomination papers or on local authority websites.

South Canterbury District Health Board candidates **must** also submit a Conflict of Interest Statement with their nominations. Requirements for a Conflict of Interest Statement are included in the Candidate Information Handbook.

All nomination documents must be lodged together (i.e. nomination paper, candidate profile, photo, deposit and Conflict of Interest Statement [for DHB candidates only]). Evidence of NZ Citizenship should also be provided.

Candidates should refer to the candidate handbook for further details.

Enrolment for inclusion on the Residential Electoral Roll is conducted through the Electoral Commission. Electors may enrol or amend their enrolment details on the Residential Electoral Roll by:

- Calling 0800 ENROL NOW (0800 36 76 56)
- Visiting the Elections website (www.elections.org.nz)
- Completing an enrolment form available at Post Shops, Public Libraries or City or District Council Offices

Updates to the preliminary electoral roll close at 4pm on Friday 16 August 2019.

Applications for registration as a ratepayer elector are to be made on the non-resident ratepayer elector enrolment form available from the respective council's website or electoral officers and must be returned to the relevant District Council Electoral Officer before 4pm Friday 16 August 2019.

Following closure of the roll, the Electoral Officer may, on application of any person who is or claims to be entitled to be enrolled or any other person or otherwise, make any necessary corrections to the names, addresses, occupations, abbreviations, or marks appearing in the electoral roll.

VOTING PERIOD

The voting period will be from Friday 20 September 2019 to 12 noon on Saturday 12 October 2019.
