INTRODUCTION

- 1 Te Pūkenga is a submitter on the Proposed Timaru District Plan (215), and filed evidence in support of its submission from the following experts:
 - 1.1 Mr Ryan Brosnahan (planning)
- 2 Te Pūkenga has sought to be heard at Hearing B – Urban Zones to be held on 24 and 25 July 2024. However, in the interests of efficiency, Te Pūkenga seek instructions from the Panel on whether it has questions Mr Brosnahan or would like to hear from him further.
