### PROPOSAL TO CLOSE CENTRAL TIMARU STREETS TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

Pursuant to the Transport (Vehicular Traffic Road Closure) Regulations 1965, notice is hereby given that the Timaru District Council for the purpose of Canterbury Caledonian Society, holding the Criterium Cycle Race, proposes to close of the following street to ordinary vehicular traffic for the period indicated hereunder.

#### Streets proposed to be temporarily closed to ordinary vehicular traffic:

- Church Street (Sophia Street – Bank Street)
- Bank Street (Church Street – Sophia Street)
- Sophia Street (Bank Street – King George Place)
- Perth Street (King George Place – Church Street)

#### Period of proposed temporary closure:

26 December 2018 | 5.30pm – 9.00pm

During the proposed period of closure the following provision will be made for ordinary vehicular traffic which would otherwise use the road:

Stafford Street
