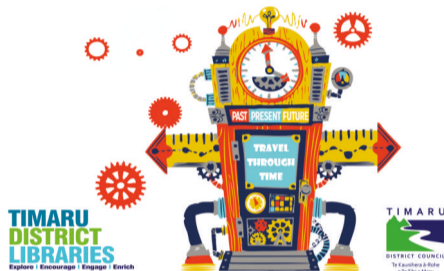

Environment Canterbury's draft Long-Term Plan asks whether you support MyWay by Metro on-demand public transport in Timaru.



Option 1: Keep MyWay by Metro

- As with all public transport, this would be funded through a targeted rate for Timaru ratepayers and from government grants. It would add about \$14 per \$100,000 of property value, per year.
- The targeted rate does not apply to ratepayers outside of the Timaru urban area, such as Pleasant Point, Temuka and Geraldine.

Option 2: MyWay would not continue beyond the trial

- We would look at adjusting, and potentially reducing, the fixed route bus system so that it is financially viable.
- We are also interested in whether you would like to see this type of on-demand public transport trialled in other communities in the future.
- You have until Sunday 11 April to tell us what you think by making a submission on the Long-Term Plan.
