8.1 Geraldine Transport Strategy Update

Recommendation

That the revised community engagement period for the Draft Geraldine Transportation Strategy now to be undertaken in October 2020 be noted.

Purpose of Report

1 To provide an update of the Geraldine Transportation strategy development and the proposal for further public consultation.

Assessment of Significance

2 This report is of low significance under the Council's Significance and Engagement Policy. However, some aspects of the Draft Strategy such as the potential relocation of SH79 or a new river bridge will have a high significance for the Geraldine community and therefore community engagement should be considered prior to the strategy finalisation

Discussion

- 3 The Draft Geraldine Transportation strategy has been developed that takes a long term view of the transportation needs of Geraldine and traffic modelling analysis was completed for years 2028 and 2045.
- 4 This draft strategy considers all modes of transport and has identified potential improvements to the efficiency, effectiveness and/or ways to increase the use of particular transport modes especially active transport. This will be an important input to informing the next Long Term Plan and Infrastructure Strategy.
- 5 It is important that we engage with the Geraldine community on the strategy and the options presented to get the community support that will facilitate a successful strategy implementation.
- 6 At the Geraldine Community Board meeting on 27 May 2020 a number of consultation options were presented. It was agreed that the community engagement will involve using print media, a drop in session and a website platform for consultation on the Draft Geraldine Transportation Strategy.
- 7 The interactive website will be the cornerstone of the engagement with the community. The interactive website will be available at the drop in sessions to enhance engagement. This has taken longer than expected to develop but is now at the stage that we can launch the site.
- 8 It is proposed that the community engagement be undertaken in October 2020.

Purpose of Report

Background

The targeted GCB rate fund which is annually collected currently has a balance of \$51,567.91.

This fund accumulates approx \$8,500.00 per annum.

Under the Local Government Act 2002 the Geraldine Community Board is delegated by the Timaru District council to determine how the money collected and provided for in the annual budget will be spent in accordance with legislation.

This can be found under the local Government Act 2002, the relevant section is Schedule7, clause 32 (1) and 32 (6).
