Citytown Trials

A key outcome of the Citytown Trials was a need to increase the use of public spaces and bring in more people. Steps leading up to the lawn area can be used as another area for seating as well as a means to access the lawn and continue the circulation flow from the seating eating areas in front of the proposed toilets.

An opportunity to provide a more permanent, mini, multipurpose amphitheatre which could double as an additional public seating area has been explored. This may be a future consideration as the city centre is develops over the coming years.





