## Signage on our footpaths

Timaru District Consolidated Bylaw 2018, Chapter 2: Public Places - Third Schedule Bylaw Policy

Portable advertising signs in the main shopping areas within our District must:

- Be displayed outside of the business being advertised
- Be no more than 600mm from the boundary of that business' premises
- Be taken down at close of business each day

Non-compliant advertising signage poses risk of injury to members of the community.

Signage that does not comply with local bylaws may be removed by Council officers at any time. Offending businesses will be charged for removal costs.

### WHAT'S ROAD RESURFACING?

Road surfacing is similar to putting a new coat of paint on your house, it makes it more waterproof and stops the old layer peeling/potholing which extends the life of the pavement beneath.

## King Street Road Repairs

**What's happening?**  
We're completing road repairs on King Street, Timaru.

**Why?**  
These repairs will fix problem areas on the road, ensuring it lasts longer and stays in good condition.

**When?**  
Works will commence 26th October 2021 and are anticipated to take 5 weeks to complete.

**Anticipated disruption?**  
One laning and detours will be used to facilitate efficient completion of works. Please follow all traffic management signs and instructions of on site staff, we apologise for any delays/inconvenience caused.

## Unwin Road Updates

**What's happening?**  
We're undertaking some significant street upgrades on Unwin Road, from the top of Marine Parade to the Hall Street intersection.

**Why?**  
These works will update the existing, ageing infrastructure and improve amenity for pedestrians and road users.

**When?**  
Works will commence on 26th October 2021, with an anticipated duration of 8 weeks.

**Anticipated disruption?**  
Signs, speed restrictions, cones, one-laning and/or other traffic controls may be used to safely guide traffic through the site. Road users may experience some traffic delays and on-street parking will be limited during works.
