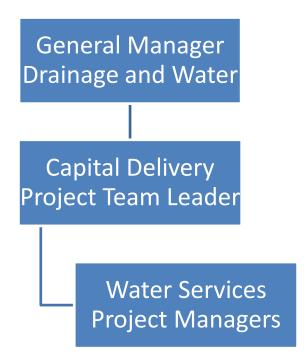

## **Business Group Purpose**

The Infrastructure Group encompasses the areas of the Drainage & Water, Land Transport, Parks & Recreation, Climate Change, Development and Waste Minimisation Units at the Timaru District Council. The Group plays a key role in delivering core services to the community, while leading and implementing the Infrastructure Strategy

across the District. This Group will be responsible for the design and implementation of strategy and programmes of work which align with the strategic priorities and Long Term Plan objectives of the Council. A key focus of the Group is to ensure infrastructure services promote the social, economic, environmental and cultural wellbeing of Timaru's communities today and in the future.

## **Purpose of the Position**

The purpose of the Water Services Project Manager position is to be responsible to the Water Services Projects Team Leader for the project management of long term asset renewal and development strategies in the Drainage and Water work programme to deliver the Council's strategies and plans. This role will manage the project activities to meet the project requirements or acceptance criteria. These projects include water services asset renewal and upgrades in urban and rural areas to achieve a safer, efficient, resilient and sustainable network. The position requires sound project management skills, knowledge and qualifications with the ability to manage the risks, issues and changes on the project, monitoring progress against plan, managing the project budget, maintaining communications with stake holders and the project organisation and closing the project in a controlled fashion when appropriate.

This role will also be responsible to contract the projects out to the contractor for construction which includes packaging the project into contract works into tender or quotation, tender or quotation evaluation, administer and manage the contract through commissioning in the role of Engineer's Representative under NZS3910 contract and develop reports.

In the delivery of projects in the work programme, the emphasis is placed on asset management considerations, statutory requirements, Council strategic directions, stakeholder consultation, and ensuring affordable best practice is incorporated in the designs and construction. This work shall be carried out in accordance with Council policies and bylaws, resource consent and public health requirements, in a professional manner and in line with standard procedures and best practices.

## **Position Responsibilities**

- 3. Provide project management expertise for Drainage and Water projects, including management of investigations, project planning, design, construction, commissioning, and ensuring that the project is within the acceptance criteria.
- 4. Prepare and implement communications strategies and plans for projects including managing inputs from internal staff, consultants, contractors, the public and other stakeholder liaison.
- 5. Assist with the Water Services Projects Team Leader preparation and implementation of annual work programmes for renewing and developing assets, and coordinate projects with other utilities.
- 6. Assist with the preparation of contract specifications and plans.
- 7. Assist in the procurement of services and support best practice.
- 8. Monitor expenditure to ensure compliance within approved budgets and annual plans for the development and renewal of Drainage and Water assets.
- Assist with the preparation of Council's Long Term Plan, annual plans and annual budgets relating to the development and renewals of Drainage and Water assets.
- 10. Ensure compliance with the Resource Management Act and any other relevant legislation or codes through obtaining resource consents and implementing appropriate monitoring programmes.

- 11. Deliver quality customer service as part of a team to external and internal customers and achieve specified performance standards.
- 12. Keep up to date with relevant technologies and best practice.
- 13. Actively engage in setting own goals, maintain professional development and objectives.
- 14. Assist with other duties as reasonably required by the Capital Delivery Project Team Leader.
- 15. Take responsibility for ensuring Council information, data and records are stored with appropriate accessibility in designated systems, using processes and tools as described in the current Information Management Policy.
- 16. To actively contribute to health, safety and wellbeing through working safely, taking responsibility for keeping self and colleagues free from harm, reporting all incidents and hazards promptly and knowing what to do in the event of an emergency.
- 17. To be actively involved in Civil Defence Emergency Management when required.
- 18. To live the COSI values; Customer Focus, One Team, Success and Integrity and consciously support a team culture that is consistent with the overall organizations values and above the line behaviors.

- Competent in the operation of computer systems with good knowledge of project management.
- Able to work as part of a team, yet also conscientiously work unsupervised.
- A willingness to learn new skills and concepts is essential.
- Good communication skills are essential, including an ability to prepare and implement communication strategies and plans.
- Excellent interpersonal skills, able to communicate clearly, respectfully and deliver verbal and written information in a logical and concise manner.
- Excellent time management skills, able to prioritise and meet deadlines
- Understanding of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015
- Ability to relate to a diverse range of internal and external stakeholders at all levels.
- Able to handle conflict situations in a professional manner and negotiate satisfactory outcomes.
- The ability to work under pressure and time constraints.
